



### **High School State Officer Points**

Applicants who score 100 points or more based on the rubric below will earn an invitation to the High School State Officer Candidate Qualifier. Applicants who pass the Qualifier will become candidates for State Office.

### **Attendance at FBLA Conferences**

A minimum of 15 points is required. Listed below are the point values for each conference. Maximum of 45 points.

5 points for each MOSAIC or ELR attended

5 points for each District Fall Planning Conference or DLC attended (current DLC registration counts)

10 points for each NFLC or MOFLC attended

10 points for each FBLA SLC attended

15 points for each NLC attended

### **Participation in Official Competitive Events**

Listed below are the point values for each competitive event. Maximum of 30 points.

5 points for placing at DLC

(1 point for each event entered but not placing at DLC)

10 points for placing at SLC

(2 point for each event entered, but not placing at SLC)

15 points for placing at NLC

(3 points for each event entered, but not placing at NLC)

## **FBLA Offices Held and Leadership Experience**

Candidates must have held an elected FBLA state, district, or local office in order to apply. Listed below are the point values for each office held. List both current and previous offices. Maximum of 45 points.

- 5 points for being a Buzz Squad member
- 10 points for serving on a National Officer Council
- 10 points for each local (chapter) office held
- 15 points for serving as a District Officer
- 20 points for serving as a State Officer

## **Business Achievement Awards/Community Service Awards**

BAA levels can be from previous BAAs and new BAAs, upload one file of all certificates. Note, the candidate must have completed two levels of the BAAs.

For candidates seeking National Nomination or State Presidency; Advocate Award is required (or Leader Level if completed prior to the new system). Maximum of 55 points.

- 5 points for Level 1
- 10 points for Level 2
- 15 points for Level 3
- 25 points for Level 4

Community Service Awards are not required to hold office. To earn points toward the State Officer Application, the candidate must complete the CSA Award. A maximum of 15 points can be awarded in this category.

- 50 Hours - 5 points
- 200 Hours - 10 points
- 500 Hours - 15 points
